

2017 BTRDA Clubmans Rallycross Championship Class Structure

In 2017 the BTRDA Clubmans Rallycross Championship will be a stand-alone championship, visiting some of the top circuits in the UK.

The BTRDA championship has categories for 2wd and 4wd Rallycross Cars;

Clubman 4*4 Category

Clubman 4x4 class based around the MSA Supercar regulations, highly modified 4x4 cars 45mm turbo restrictors, Production 4x4 based upon standard UK based 4x4 cars with limited modifications.

- Clubman 4*4
- Production 4*4

Super Modified Category;

Highly modified 2wd cars which also includes a class for the BMW Minis

- Up to 1600 (including Super 1600)
- 1601-2100
- 2101 and over (including Turbo and Supercharged cars)
- BMW Mini 1600cc R53

Production Category;

3 classes, based upon standard production based vehicles

- Up to 1600cc 8v
- Up to 1600cc 16v
- 1601cc to 2000cc 16v plus VVT cars

Pre 1995 2wd Historic Category;

No sequential gearboxes allowed, engines can have an increase of 25% on top of what the manufacturer originally made for the car, but must be in original position, No weight limit for 2017, tyres free.

- Historic Super Modified Pre 1995 shell, with 'modern' running gear
- Historic Modified Pre 1995 shell, using period running gear
- 1300cc Classic Mini

Junior Rallycross Category (14-16 years old);

Standard production based cars up to 1400cc

• Up to 1400cc Rallycross Car

The 'final' regulations will be online once MSA approved prior to Round 1 of the Championship
