

2020 BTRDA Clubman's Rallycross Championship presented by Cooper Tires

Dear drivers,

I am sure you can all agree that it is a great relief to have now been able to start our 2020 Championship, albeit 6 months later than originally planned! For those of you who competed, I hope you enjoyed your weekend. For those who were unable to compete, I hope we can welcome you to an event soon.

May I please take this opportunity to ask you to familiarise yourself with the Motorsport UK Covid-19 guidance and to ensure that you are also familiar with the guidance on this situation set out in the Final Instructions of the organising club going forward. Certainly for our next event at Blyton, face masks must be worn at all times, by all members of the team (those under the age of 11 are exempt as per Government Guidelines).

A refresher regarding regulations –

- 1. Please ensure your race numbers comply with supplementary regulation 5.3.3 as below. Several cars were identified at Lydden Hill who were not compliant with this. This will be monitored again at Blyton and if correct numbers are not used, the matter will be referred to the eligibility scrutineer for further action as appropriate. Numbers will not be provided.
- "5.3.3. Numbers will conform to Motorsport UK regulation Section Q 11.4 (Yellow and in read side window on both sides of vehicle).

In addition, a number will be applied to the top left of the front screen".

- 2. Please can I remind you that any form of pit to car radio <u>is not permitted</u>. This is highlighted in Supplementary Regulation 5.1.2 as below. This includes the use of mobile phones and Bluetooth devices. Any driver suspected of using pit to car radio will be investigated and acted on appropriately.
- "5.1.2. Any form of radio or other tele- communication with a competitor whilst on track is strictly prohibited in all classes".
